### Uniform Expectations

Thank you for supporting the school's behaviour policy by ensuring your son/daughter complies with the uniform expectations. The vast majority of students look fantastic and this also translates into excellent behaviour both in lessons and in social times.

I just wanted to outline expectations around jewellery. The planner states:

*'Jewellery: for health and safety reasons students are asked not to wear jewellery, apart from watches and earrings (one pair of small studs only.) No facial jewellery is permitted.'*

For clarification, this means that students may **only wear stud earrings**. Hoops and any other form of earring are not permitted, and students may only wear **one stud per ear**.

We have seen an emergence of students with more than one piercing, different types of earrings, or facial piercings. Whilst these may be fashionable, they are not appropriate for school. Please could you speak with your son/daughter if this is the case, and ensure that all other earrings are removed for school. Form tutors have been asked to check daily and students will be asked to remove additional earrings and their responsibility card will be signed. After half term, any student who refuses to do so, or who continues not to comply, will be placed in isolation until the situation is rectified.
