As you will know, year 10 students have been studying towards a Level 2 qualification in financial education. Not only is this course an equivalent to a full GCSE, but it also provides students with valuable knowledge of our economy, taxation, personal finance and more.

Students have been delivered the course content through form sessions, maths lessons and lectures with the senior leadership team.

We are fast approaching the assessments for this course and I wanted to inform you of the dates for the assessments, the support being provided within school and how you can support your child over the next 2 weeks.

The table below details a breakdown of the course units, assessment dates and support being put in place for each unit.

Unit	Assessment date	Support
Unit 1 – Finance, the individual and society	Thursday 21st June (45 minute online multi-choice test)	Preparation during form sessions – Students will complete mock assessments which can be used for revision at home along with a revision booklet. Twilight lesson – Tuesday 19th June, 2:50-3:50pm (compulsory to all students)
Unit 2 – Practices of managing money	Friday 22nd June (45 minute online multi-choice test)	Preparation during maths lessons – Students will complete mock assessments which can be used for revision at home along with a revision booklet. Twilight lesson – Thursday 21st June, 2:50-3:50pm (Compulsory to all students)
Unit 3 – Financial capability, work and enterprise	Wednesday 27th June (9am start) (1 hour assessment based on pre-released case study)	Monday 25th June and Tuesday 26th June , all students will be off timetable to go through key content and to look at the pre-released material.
