<p><b>Sixth Form (Y12 &amp; 13)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vision and School Values</li> <li>• British Values Democracy</li> <li>• British Values Rule of Law</li> <li>• British Values Individual Liberty/Mutual Respect</li> <li>• The Importance of Charity</li> <li>• Conflict Resolution/Preventing Radicalisation</li> <li>• Holocaust Memorial week</li> <li>• LGBT Awareness</li> <li>• Gangs</li> <li>• Political Parties (debate &amp; argument)</li> <li>• Personal wellbeing ( body awareness/ FGM/ Specialist speakers in)</li> <li>• Child Exploitation/Trafficking</li> <li>• Emotional Wellbeing Awareness</li> <li>• Higher Education Information</li> <li>• Careers Education               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Unifrog</li> <li>○ Princes Trust</li> <li>○ Progression Module</li> <li>○ Futures Programme</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Consent in a Relationship:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Students discuss and recap what consent means and is why it is important within a relationship.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Recap of Risks or Alcohol and Drug Taking</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Students focus on the consequences of alcohol and drug use in risk taking (sexual relationships), the session will specifically focus on inappropriate behaviours (through legal and illegal substances.</li> <li>➤ Students also focus on how this topic can impact Road safety/ personal safety/ reputation and career</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Road Safety</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Students discuss the subject of road safety and the consequences of not being safe ( outside speaker) other ideas discussed include: passenger safety/ using unlicensed taxis/different types of travelling and safety.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>First aid Training</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All sixth form students receive first aid training; this includes a specific focus around CPR.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>HIV Awareness (outside speaker)</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Students discuss the topic of HIV, the current awareness of the disease and how people live their life with it.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Careers / Further Education</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Students discuss career choices and ways in which they want to plan and progress with the next steps of their life and education.           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Guest Speakers</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
